

CONDUCTORS

David Hoyt has studied piano, French horn and worked with several renowned mentors. He joined the Edmonton Symphony Orchestra (ESO) while a student at the University of Alberta, becoming principal horn in 1975. David became assistant conductor of the ESO in 1985 and of the Canadian Opera Company in 1991. He has been a guest conductor with many orchestras and ensembles in Canada and the USA. David has a long association with The Banff Centre as a visiting artist and faculty member and, from 2004 - 2005, as Artistic Director/Executive Director of "Music and Sound". He spent 10 years teaching horn at the University of Alberta and has taught across the country at many festivals and music camps. As the head of Education and Outreach at the ESO, David expanded and founded several popular concert series. David has been principal conductor of the Mill Creek Colliery Band since 2012.



Lieutenant Lucas Denneboom is a multi-instrumentalist, conductor, music producer, and band geek. Originally from Brockville, Ontario, Lucas earned a Bachelor of Music in Jazz Drum Set Performance from St. FX University in 2016. Joining the Canadian Armed Forces immediately upon graduation, he was posted to the Royal Canadian Artillery Band in Edmonton as a percussionist. While working in the band, he studied conducting with Dr. Angela Schroeder at the University of Alberta, earning a master's degree in Wind Band Conducting in 2021. He accepted a commission and was appointed Assistant Director of Music of the RCA Band in July of 2022. Lucas has also appeared with the Edmonton Symphony Orchestra, Symphony Nova Scotia, and the Band of the Ceremonial Guard, and is thrilled to be joining forces with the Mill Creek Colliery Band for the second time as guest conductor.
